Victims: Lisa Gurrieri – 19 years old and Brandon Rumbaugh – 20 years old

Location: Bumble Bee Campsite – about 2 miles west of I-17 highway in Yavapai County

Date: Between Friday, October 17, 2003 at 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, October 18, 2003 at 8:00 a.m.

Suspect(s): Unknown

Vehicle: Victim's vehicle, 2000 white Ford F-150 pick-up truck, was recovered

On Friday, October 17, 2003, Brandon Rumbaugh and Lisa Gurrieri celebrated their one-year anniversary by camping overnight in Yavapai County. They borrowed a pick-up truck and planned on returning the next morning. When the couple did not return, family and friends searched possible locations where they may have camped. Brandon and Lisa's bodies were later found in their truck bed that was parked at a secluded dirt area in the Bumble Bee Camp of Yavapai County. They both had fatal gunshot wounds.
